#### Rules and Regulations – Judged Show

- 1. Entry for members and youth is free. For non-members, the fee is **\$5 per quilt**. Checks should be made payable to Midland Quilters' Guild and mailed with your entry form. Entries must never have been shown in a prior MQG show, with the exception of any Special Exhibit items.
- 2. Maximum number of entries per person is five (5) with a maximum of two (2) entries in any one category. Show Theme category is a bonus entry and will not be counted in your total, nor will any Special Exhibit items. Please note that there is a different entry form for Special Exhibit items. We can accept only 200 guilts for the 2023 show. If your forms reach us after the limit has been reached, we will notify you.
- 3. Entry forms may be turned in at MQG chapter meetings or mailed (postmarked by **Thursday**, **August 24**, **2023**.) **Each item must have a separate**, **signed entry form** with a photo attached (stapled to the back of the form facing out.) Mailed forms should be sent to **Muff Fregia**, **4723 Spring Meadow Lane Unit 3**, **Midland TX 79705**. The photo may be printed on regular paper.
- 4. Hanging sleeves. All quilts must have a hanging sleeve **sewn**, **not pinned**. Small quilts may have a 2" opening sleeve. Medium and Large quilts need a 4" opening sleeve. The sleeve will be at the top of the quilt next to the binding unless the quilt is longer than 93". If the quilt is longer than 93", place the top of the 4" opening sleeve at 93" from the quilt bottom, and sew it to the back of the quilt so that the quilt will not touch the floor when hung. Please sew around all 4 edges of the sleeve.
- 5. Each entry is required to have a cloth **label** sewn to the lower back edge with the maker's name and title of the entry. All entries must be finished.
- 6. Each entry is required to be delivered in a separate cloth pillowcase labeled with the entrant's name, phone and address clearly written with a permanent marker. NO STRAIGHT PINS! NO PLASTIC BAGS! NO PET HAIR or ODORS (see Rule 7.)
- 7. Each entry must be clean, free from animal hair, and free from odors. Any quilt or pillowcase with animal hair or noticeable scent from laundry products, perfumes, or smoke will not be accepted or hung. Hint: use a lint roller if you have a pet in your home. Use it until that roller is clean! Cat hair in particular clings to fabrics, so please be diligent.
- 8. All entries will stay for the duration of the show. **Pick-up time is between 6:30 p.m.** and **7:30 p.m.**, **Saturday, Oct 7.** All entries are to be picked up after the show from the Distribution committee, located within the show premises, **105 N. Main, Midland TX 79701**. There will be no exceptions. If you cannot pick up your entries during this time, please arrange for someone else to do so. The quilt entry number receipt for each quilt must be presented before we will release any entry.

#### **Explanation of Categories**

The committee has the right to change any entry's category if considered necessary. If a change is made, you will be contacted with an explanation of the change.

**Perimeter** means the total of all sides of the quilt.

<u>The two-person (or group) categories</u> are for any works (other than youth) which were made by more than one person (such as a top made by one person and quilted by another.)

<u>Pieced</u> Quilts - quilt is predominately pieced. Enter the proper category depending on the quilt size and number of makers.

**Appliqué Quilts - the appliqué dominates over other techniques in amount or in effect.** Constructed by one person, two people or group.

Embroidery Quilts - constructed on a machine or by hand. Constructed by one person, two people or group

Mixed Technique Quilts - a balanced combination of both applique and piecing. Constructed by one person, two people or group.

<u>Art</u> - original design, composed without copying the works of others. Visibly quilted through all three layers: quilt top, batting & backing. Constructed by one person.

<u>Miniature</u> - must represent a full size quilt, proportionately scaled down. If blocks are used, they should not be larger than 4" square. Perimeter not to exceed 100". Constructed by one person, two people or group.

**Wearable Art – clothing constructed referencing guilting techniques. Batting not required.** Constructed by one person.

Show Theme Category – is your interpretation of the quilt show theme title. Quilts not to exceed 40" x 40". Constructed by one person.

<u>Modern</u> - Inspired by clean, modern design. Could include focus on negative space, bold or solid colors, and/or improvisation. No size restriction. Constructed by one person.

<u>Youth Category</u> – Made primarily by a person who will be less than 18 on Oct 5, 2023. Youth may have the help of another person, whose name and relationship should be noted on the entry form along with that of the youth. No size restriction. Youth entering other categories must abide by those rules.
